

South Florida Community Gardens

At community gardens you can grow your own food in small plots with the support of other gardeners or garden communally and take home a share of what is produced. Some charge an annual fee to cover things like water, supplies, etc. Some are full so you will have to put your name on a waiting list. Not on this list are the many school gardens. See Google map of local school and community gardens. For areas outside South Florida, be sure to check the American Community Garden Association's list of community gardens.
